

Prof. Abid Haleem



He is a distinguished Professor of Mechanical Engineering at Jamia Millia Islamia (A Central University established by an Act of Parliament), New Delhi, India. Over a highly accomplished career, he has made significant contributions to engineering and management education, research, and institutional development.

He was instrumental in starting the MBA (Evening) Programme at Jamia Millia Islamia and led it successfully for 14 years. He also founded the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) at the university and served as its first Honorary Director. As Head of the Department of Mechanical Engineering, Prof. Haleem provided strategic vision and aligned the department with evolving industrial and academic trends. In addition, he served as Professor In-Charge of the Residential Coaching Academy (RCA), mentoring civil services aspirants through structured guidance and mock interviews.

Prof. Haleem's teaching and research interests span Supply Chain Management, Green and Halal Supply Chains, Additive Manufacturing, Healthcare Technologies and Management, Innovation, Sustainability, and Engineering Management. His scholarly influence is reflected in over **54,000 citations**, an **h-index of 110**, and an **i10-index of 348** as of 2025 (Google Scholar). He has consistently ranked among the **Top 2% of scientists worldwide** in the Elsevier–Stanford University global ranking from 2019 to 2025, currently placed at **1,878 globally**.

He serves as Regional Editor (Asia–Pacific) for the *Global Journal of Flexible Systems Management* (Springer), Associate Editor for *MAPAN* (Springer), and the *Journal of Clinical Orthopaedics and Trauma* (Elsevier). He is also on the editorial boards of several reputed journals and has guest-edited special issues for Scopus- and SCI-indexed journals. A Fellow of AGBA, he holds life memberships with several professional bodies including IIIE, ISME, ISTE, GIFT, SCL, IICC, and ISC, and has served as both President and Secretary of GIFT and AGBA.

His consultancy portfolio includes assignments with DFID, the Government of Odisha, and EdCIL. He has also served as a High Court-appointed arbitrator at DIAC, contributing his expertise in technical and managerial dispute resolution. Prof. Haleem has led numerous funded research projects supported by DST, AICTE, UGC, and FIST. Beyond academia, he is an Independent Director at Telecommunications Consultants India Ltd., Advisor to DTDC Ltd., and a member of the Ad-hoc Task Force under the Cabinet Secretariat, where he contributes to policy formulation and institutional accreditation initiatives.
